




Deep North

Ras Mohammed National Park

Ras Mohammed lies south of the Sinaí peninsula. it became Egypt's first protected national park in 1983. Initially covering 97 km², the park has since been extended to 480 km². due to its great beauty and scientific importance, the park is exceptionally well-preserved thanks to public awareness and ongoing surveillance both on land and at sea.

Among all the dive sites in the park, the most notable are Shark & Yolanda Reef and Jack Fish Alley. Here, we'll discover the immense and colorful marine life that awaits in one of the best areas of Egypt's northern Red Sea route.





Straits of Tiran

The Straits of Tiran, located between the the Sinai Peninsula and Tiran Island, is one of the most iconic diving areas in the Red Sea. This strait is famous for its spectacular marine biodiversity and stunning coral reefs.

One of the best known reefs is Jackson Reef, where breathtaking coral walls await you. Enjoy the beauty of Wood House Reef, with its vibrant coral gardens and turtles. At Gordon Reef, you'll encounter a variety of fish in a spectacular setting.





Dahab


Dahab has become one of the most attractive diving destinations that you must not miss while in Egypt. The reefs are stunning, with a variety of species that create colorful underwater landscapes.

Blue Hole: This famous site is known for its impressive underwater cave and deep blue waters.

The Canyon: A spectacular system of coral formations and vertical walls. The dive here is breathtaking and the play on light creates a magical atmosphere.

Gabr El Bint: One of the most popular dives and famous for its coral reefs and rich marine life.





Abu Nuhas

Abu Nuhas, known as the "Shipwreck Cemetery," is famous for the numerous wrecks resting in its crystal-clear waters. Among the most iconic wrecks is the Giannis D, a Greek cargo ship that sank in 1983 after hitting a coral reef. At about 28 meters deep, its structure is covered in corals and is home to a diverse array of colorful fish and turtles, making it a fascinating spot to explore.

Another highlight is the Carnatic, an old cargo ship that sank in 1881. Its impressive bow and vertical mast are easily recognizable. Located at around 30 meters deep, this wreck also hosts a rich marine life and it is typical to find tuna and groupers.

Hurghada Reefs

We will also dive in the reefs near Hurghada, which offer a wide variety of dive sites, where we'll explore walls adorned with coral gardens teeming with tropical fish.



Itinerary

DAY 1 Arrival, check-in, general briefing, dinner. First night spent on board in the marina.

DAY 2 Check dive, second dive, night dive, then sail to Sinai.

DAY 3 Dive at Ras Mohammed Shark & Yolanda Reef, Jack Fish Alley, Ras Umm Sid, (The Temple) and night dive. Then sail to Dahab.

DAY 4 Dive at Blue Hole, Canyon, Gabr El Bint, night dive. Then sail to Tiran.

DAY 5 Dive at Jackson Reef, Wood House, Gordon Reef, night dive. Then sail to Abu Nuhas.

DAY 6 Dive at Giannis D, Carnatic, Yellow Reef, night dive, then sail to Hurghada.

DAY 7 Dive at Sha'ab El Erg, Careless Reef, then return to the marina.

DAY 8 Breakfast and check-out.

Tips for the staff

Booking and Cancellation policy

- o A 25% deposit is required via bank transfer to confirm the reservation.
- A second 25% payment must be made via bank transfer 2 months before departure.
- o The remaining 50% is to be paid in cash (in euros) at check-in on the boat.

In case of cancellation, the following charges apply:

- o 90 to 61 days before the arrival date: 25% of the safari price
- o 60 to 45 days before the arrival date: 50% of the safari price
- o The initial 25% deposit is non-refundable

FAQ

Do I need a visa to enter Egypt?

Yes, you will need a visa. Remember that your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your arrival date. You can obtain the visa at the airport upon arrival, right after you leave the plane, and it costs 25 USD.

Do I need diving insurance?

Yes, diving insurance is mandatory. It can be purchased on board for 10 euros. The D.E.C.O card (Diving Emergency Center Organization) is valid for 2 weeks and covers the first hyperbaric chamber.

What diving equipment should I bring?

You should bring a dive computer, surface marker buoy (SMB), snorkel, regulator, BCD, mask, fins, and a wetsuit. We recommend bringing some spare parts. If you need to rent equipment, please contact us before the trip.

Remember to also bring your diving certification and logbook, showing the number of dives you have completed.

What should I bear in mind?

It is strictly forbidden to hunt, fish, collect, touch corals or shells, throw anything into the sea, or feed fish. Gloves and knives are prohibited.

Violating these rules may result in the suspension of the crew and the boat from working for a period of time.
