You'll dive into crystal-clear waters, where dolphins often play and swim in groups, performing acrobatics that will amaze you. Additionally, Sataya offers fantastic diving opportunities with vibrant reefs full of marine life, from clownfish to colorful corals.






St John's

Diving in St. Johns is like entering a true underwater paradise. This iconic Red Sea destination is famous for its incredible coral reefs and rich marine life. As you descend, you'll be surrounded by colorful landscapes, where both hard and soft corals create a fascinating maze.

In this area, you will also explore Dangerous Reef, known for its stunning caves and coral walls that house an amazing variety of life. Here, you can spot parrotfish, groupers, and reef sharks, and with a bit of luck, even hammerhead sharks. The caves offer shelter to small wonders, such as nudibranchs and scorpionfish.



Fury Shoals

Fury Shoals is an underwater paradise known for its stunning diversity and vibrant corals. At Sha'ab Claudia, you'll dive into coral gardens that are home to turtles and sharks, making for an unforgettable encounter with marine life.

Exploring Sha'ab Maksour is a fascinating adventure, where coral walls rise majestically and large schools of tropical fish swim in harmony. At Malahi, the gentle currents and abundant marine life offer you the opportunity, with some luck, to spot mantas and dolphins swimming alongside you.





Itinerary

DAY 1 Arrival, check-in, general briefing, dinner. First night spent on board in the marina.

DAY 2 Check dive, second dive, then sail to Sataya.

DAY 3 Dive at Sha'ab Maksur North, Sha'ab Maksur South, Sataya South, night dive, then sail to Rocky Island.

DAY 4 Two Dives at Rocky Island, Zabargad, then sail to St. John's, night dive at St. John's.

DAY 5 Dive at Habili Gaffar, Gota Sogyara, Dangerous Reef, Om El Khararim, night dive, then sail to Sataya.

DAY 6 Dive at Sataya North, Sha'ab Malahi, Sha'ab Claudia, night dive, then sail to Marsa Alam.

DAY 7 Two dives along the coast of Marsa Alam before sailing back to the marina. Dives at Habili Marsa Alam, Habili Ghadir.

DAY 8 Breakfast and check-out.

Tips for the staff

Booking and Cancellation policy

- o A 25% deposit is required via bank transfer to confirm the reservation.
- A second 25% payment must be made via bank transfer 2 months before departure.
- The remaining 50% is to be paid in cash (in euros) at check-in on the boat.

In case of cancellation, the following charges apply:

- o 90 to 61 days before the arrival date: 25% of the safari price
- o 60 to 45 days before the arrival date: 50% of the safari price
- o The initial 25% deposit is non-refundable

FAQ

Do I need a visa to enter Egypt?

Yes, you will need a visa. Remember that your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your arrival date. You can obtain the visa at the airport upon arrival, right after you leave the plane, and it costs 25 USD.

Do I need diving insurance?

Yes, diving insurance is mandatory. It can be purchased on board for 10 euros. The D.E.C.O card (Diving Emergency Center Organization) is valid for 2 weeks and covers the first hyperbaric chamber.

What diving equipment should I bring?

You should bring a dive computer, surface marker buoy (SMB), snorkel, regulator, BCD, mask, fins, and a wetsuit. We recommend bringing some spare parts. If you need to rent equipment, please contact us before the trip.

Remember to also bring your diving certification and logbook, showing the number of dives you have completed.

What should I bear in mind?

It is strictly forbidden to hunt, fish, collect, touch corals or shells, throw anything into the sea, or feed fish. Gloves and knives are prohibited.

Violating these rules may result in the suspension of the crew and the boat from working for a period of time.
